

## Schwallie Family Scholarship Application Checklist

Please include everything on the following checklist. Applications that are incomplete will not be accepted.

- A completed application form, downloadable from the website
- Documentation of status as a person on the autism spectrum
- Documentation of acceptance or attendance at a qualifying institution
- A written Letter of Recommendation from someone other than a family member, who is familiar with the individual's potential to complete the required coursework  
NOTE: Original and signed letter is required
- An autobiographical essay, not to exceed 1,000 words, including your reasons for applying for the Schwallie Family Scholarship. Please note that the essay is expected to be solely the work of the applicant and not that of family members or other involved parties.
- THREE (3) copies of each item listed above
